Cultivar	Areas of Best Fruit Quality	Skin Color	Flesh Color	Comments
Adriatic	Coast & Inland	Green-Yellow	Red	All purpose variety. Especially good dried
Black Jack	Coast & Inland	Purple-Black	Red	Good variety for containers. Large fruit.
Black Madeira	Coast & Inland	Purple-Black	Red	Better flavor than 'Black Mission.
Black Mission	Coast & Inland	Purple-Black	Red	Distinct rich flavor. Not good in desert areas.
Brown Turkey	Coast & Inland	Purple-Brown	Cream	All purpose variety. Best for fresh eating.
Celeste (Blue Celeste, Celestial)	Coast & Inland	Bronze-Violet	Rosy Amber	Fruit has a tightly closed eye. One of the sweetest varieties.
Conadria	Inland	Green-Yellow	Cream/Red	Excellent flavor. Best fig for drying.
Denny	Inland	Purple-Black	Cream/Red	Dwarf tree to maximum of 8 feet.
Excell	Coast & Inland	Yellow	Amber	Superb all purpose fig. Rich flavor.
Flanders	Coast & Inland	Violet	Amber	Excellent flavor.
Italian Everbearing	Coast & Inland	Purple-Brown	Pink	Bears continuously through summer & into the fall.
Kadota	Inland	Green-Yellow	Amber/Pink	All purpose variety. Commercial canning fig-
King (Desert King)	Coast	Green	Violet/Pink	Produces a heavy early (breba) crop. A San Pedro-type fig. Usually produces a main crop without a pollinizer.
Osborn	Coast & Inland	Purple-Brown	Amber	A very large fig. Will produce a light breba crop. A very productive fig.
Panache	Inland	Green & Yellow	Red	Beautiful green & yellow striping on fruit. Young branches also variegated. Needs hot summer temperatures to ripen properly.
Pasquale	Coast & Inland	Black-Purple	Red	Small fruit with very rich flavor. Very late ripening fig, often ripens in Dec. or Jan.
Peter's Honey (Italian Honey)	Coast & Inland	Yellow-Green	Amber	Very sweet. Often produces a drop of nectar at the "eye" when ripe. May produce a breba crop.
Tena	Coast & Inland	Light Green	Amber	Bears good breba crop. Fine flavored fig with a medium eye.
Texas Everbearing	Coast & Inland	Purple-Brown	Amber	Fruit has a closed eye. Fruit born continuously summer-fall.
Verte	Coast & Inland	Green-Yellow	Red	Bears good breba crop. Small tree.
White Genoa	Coast	Yellow-Green	Amber	Not good for drying.
