Cultivar	Estimated Chill Hours Required	Fruit Season	Skin Color	Flavor	Comments
Anna	100 or less	Early and Mid	Red& Green	Sweet-Tart	Heavy producer with or without pollinizer. Fruit will fill out if pollinizer. Strong tendency to double or triple crop
Adina	200-300	Mid	Red	Sweet	Flavor has cinnamon overtones. Pollinizer required.
Beverly Hills	100 or less	Early	Yellow & Red	Tart-Sweet	Will not develop good quality in hot interior areas.
Dorsett Golden	100 or less	Early and Mid	Yellow & Red	Sweet	Has tendency to double crop. Pollinates 'Anna'
Early Dawn	200-300	Mid	Red& Green	Sweet-Tart	Cut fruit slow to discolor. Pollinizer required.
Ein Shemer	100-200	Early	Yellow Green	Sweet-Tart	Pollinates 'Anna'
Fuji	300-400	Late	Green & Red	Sweet	Keeps very well. Becoming a very popular variety.
Golden Delicious	300-400	Mid	Yellow	Sweet	Best 'Delicious' variety for low chill areas.
Gordon	250-350	Mid	Green & Red	Sweet-Tart	
Granny Smith	300-400	Late	Yellow Green	Tart	Australian favorite. Tree ripened fruit is sweeter than store bought.
Michel	100-200	Mid	Red& Green	Sweet	
Mutsu	350-450	Late	Yellow Green	Sweet-Tart	Needs pollinator. Has won many tasting competitions for best flavor.
Pettingill	100-200	Mid-Late	Red& Green	Tart	
Red Fuji	300-400	Mid-Late	Red& Green	Sweet	Very Crisp & Flavorful. Bud sport of Fuji.

Tropic Beauty	100 or less	Mid	Red	Sweet	Pollinates 'Adina'. Production not required but production enhanced if pollinized by 'Adina'.
Valmour	150-250	Mid	Red& Yellow	Sweet-Tart	
Winter Banana	100 or less	Mid	Yellow Green	Sweet-Tart	Needs pollinator. There is a spur fruiting form.
White Pearmain	250-350	Mid		Sweet-Tart	Needs pollinator. Tender flesh, excellent flavor.
